What a mixture of science and creativity we had! Year 4 loved sharing their knowledge of the water cycle by making their own science displays. Very eye-catching!





'As of May 2018, WhatsApp's <b>minimum age of use</b> is 16 years old. It was previously 13If WhatsApp learns that identifiable information of a child under 16 has been collected on the WhatsApp Site or WhatsApp Service, then WhatsApp may deactivate the account.					
			Children can only talk to existing contacts on their phone. Although this may feel safer, it's still important to remember that some content shared may not be appropriate for children, or they have contacts (strangers) in their phone who they have		
over your child's digital footprint, particularly the content (photos, videos and messages) they choose					
to share via WhatsApp. Once shared, it can be copied, re shared and posted anywhere online.'
