Thursday 9th May 2019

The summer topic for Year 3 is Roman Britain. In order to give the children a real insight into Roman life in Britain, we will be taking them to the Dewa Roman experience in Chester. Here the children will be given a guided tour of the museum where they will discover the genuine Roman, Saxon and Medieval remains beneath Chester. Alongside these they will see the display of a collection of Roman artefacts from Chester and the Roman Empire, have an opportunity to enjoy the many games and historically based activities on offer, such as trying on full size Roman armour. In addition to the museum tour they will also receive a Roman soldier patrol through the streets of ancient Chester.

This is a fantastic learning experience and an ideal way to conclude our theme for the term. Our trip will be on **Thursday 6th June 2019**. We will be leaving at **9.45am** prompt in order to get to Chester in time to start our activities at **11.45am** and we will be home in time for **4.30pm**.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £12.35 to cover the cost of admission, the Tour and transport.
