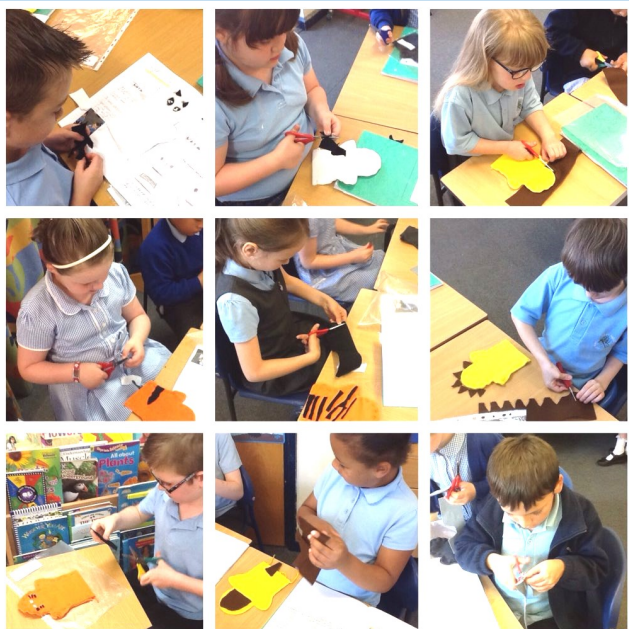

**School Drop Off**

Please can we ask parents to ensure that they drop their children off safely at school and that late children are bought to the office and booked in by an adult.
