From the Headteacher

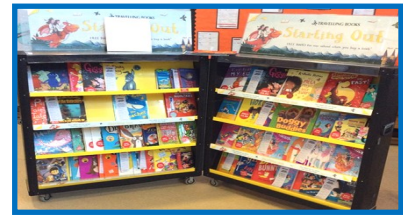
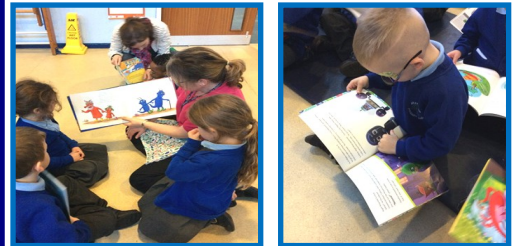
