<p><b>Science – Plants and Seasonal Changes</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Plant a seed and record what happens as it grows. Maybe you could do this by taking photographs or drawing pictures, taking measurements of the stem and leaves, or keeping a plant diary.</li><li>• Write a set of instructions for how to grow a plant. What changes can you see?
