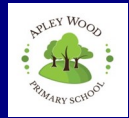

Headteacher News

I hope you have all had a good week and are keeping well. Thank you for the positive feedback and supportive messages myself and the staff have received this week.

It has been a hugely successful week for home learning. Some of the activities completed include, curry making, stem projects, reading, creating and writing farmyard books, gardening, learning DIY skills, music lessons, creative space models, singing, computing work and a lot of successful maths work. The photographs and messages about home learning successes are fantastic and make all the staff smile. We really do enjoy seeing and hearing about them.

Currently, we are in the planning stages to bring Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 into school from the 1st June **IF** the government decides it is safe to do so and subject to our own risk assessments. If this is the case, then in order to do this as safely as possible, we are considering a phased approach with Reception and/or Y1 starting back first. We are in the process of making calls to parents of these year groups to ascertain your views.

We will be sending more detail out next week once we have finalised arrangements and had any additional information from the Government and Local Authority.

We are working in very challenging times and being asked to educate children very differently within some significant constraints. I want to give you my full assurance that we will do everything possible to ensure the safety of your child and our staff and to make school that happy, welcoming place they know.

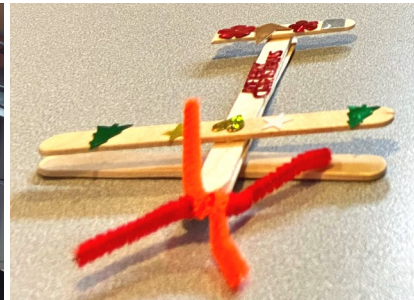

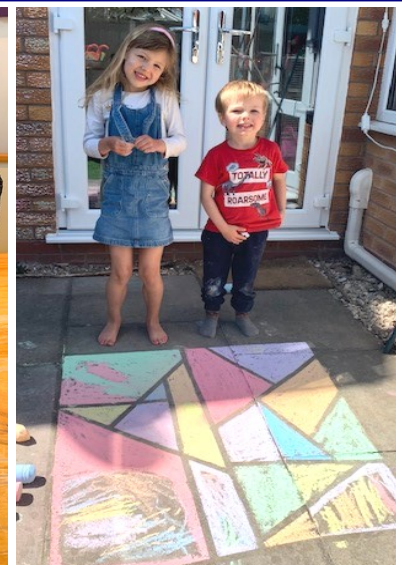
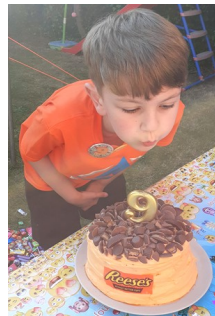

Some of the children (attending the emergency provision) have been creating patterns and pictures out of natural materials. Very creative, well done everyone. Mrs Yale.

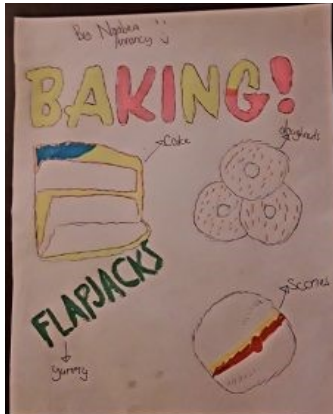
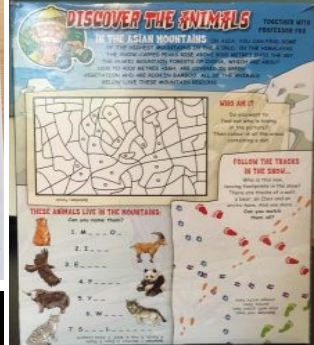
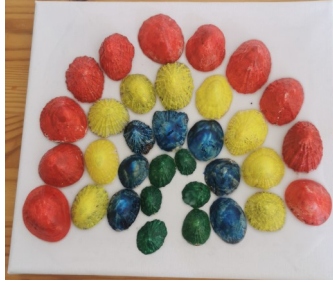
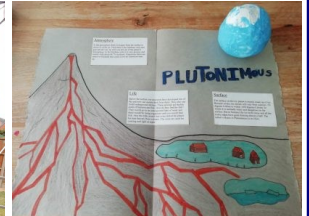


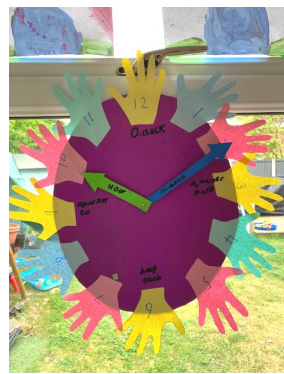
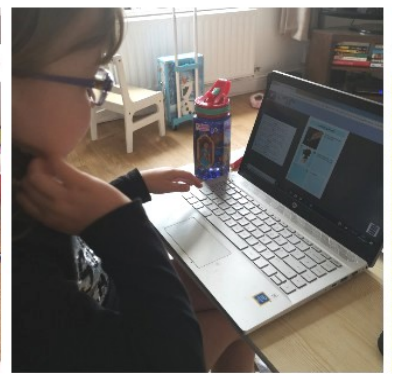
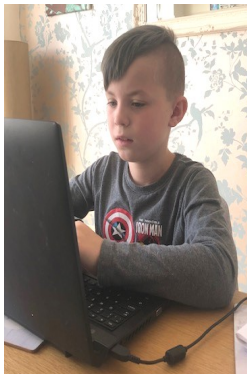
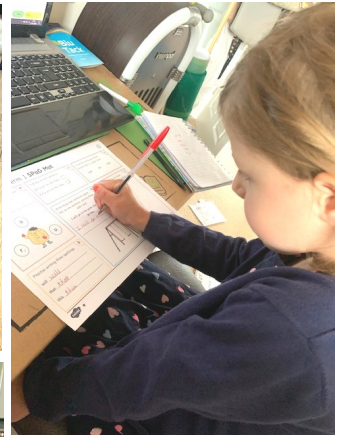
