Can you tell the time? What happens at six o'clock. Can children talk about what they do at 6 o'clock at home. Ask children to talk to their parents about the time 6 o'clock and find out what they do at that time. Draw a picture of what you do at that time.</p>	<p>Can you set up a tea party for the three bears? Can you find 3 cups, bowls, spoons and plates. Can you sort them according to their size? A big bowl for Daddy, medium for Mummy and small for baby.</p>

Thurs	<p>Miss Smith's Phonics group Learn to say and write t Read words sad, sat</p> <p>Mrs Yale and Mrs Pitt's Phonics group Learn to say and write j Read words vet, yap, yes</p> <p>Miss Holbrook's phonics group Learn to say and write ng Read words sing, wing, king</p> <p>Ms Wilson's phonics group Learn to say and write ch Read words chop, chip, chin</p>	<p>Get an egg box. Ask the child-how many eggs can we fit in the box? Can we work out a quicker way than counting? Point out 3 spaces on one side and 3 on the other $3+3=6$</p> <p>Roll a dice and fill your egg box with that many objects. How many more do you need to fill the box-add with another colour. E.g roll a 4-emphasise 6 eggs all together, 4 are red and 2 are yellow. 6 is the whole, 4 and 2 are the parts.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you record as a number sentence?</p>	<p>Shared write a list of rules that Goldilocks should follow What did Goldilocks do wrong? E.g. Do not go into a stranger's house. Say sorry. Do not use other people's things.</p>

Talk about the new shape hexagon you have made. How many sides has it got? Record next to your new shape.</p>	<p>PE</p> <p>Exploring jumping. Jump high and low. Think about different animal jumps: bunny/frog. Model good jumping:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Ensure the children bend their legs when landing a jump. o Encourage the children to allow their knees to give a little when landing.
