Tuesday	STEAM Week Activities Boat challenge Complete the worksheet where children design a boat out of minimal items and then get it to sail across some water without sinking. Evaluate boat challenge. Complete the questions to evaluate what had happened and discuss how the children could make improvements.	Reading: Read own book for 30 minutes.	STEAM Week Activities Investigation Test materials to check which is most waterproof using pipettes and a selection of 6 materials. Count how many water droplets it holds before tearing or getting very wet/dripping.
Wednesday	STEAM Week Activities Design and make a boat. Children to design a boat using the best material from their investigation. Complete the sheet and then create it using the material.	Reading: Read own book for 30 minutes.	STEAM Week Activities Test boat and evaluate. Test boats to see if they have improved and then complete evaluation questions.
