What Are We Learning?

We are learning to compare the number of letters in names, using the vocabulary 'more', 'fewer' and 'the same'.

How to Set up the Challenge

- Provide your child with a piece of paper and a pen or pencil.
- Ask them to write their name at the top of the piece of paper and think of the names of friends and family members.
- Help your child to spell the names of family and friends where required.

How to Get Your Child Thinking

- Can you write your name?
- Can you count how many letters are in your name?
- Think of the name of a friend. How many letters are in their name?
- Is that more letters, fewer letters or the same number of letters as your name?
- Can you think of a name that has more letters than your name?
 How can you check?
- Can you think of a name that has fewer letters than your name?
 How can you check?
- Can you think of a name that has the same number of letters as your name? How do you know?
