Following Clair's fantastic achievements at last years marathon she has been accepted to once again run for Severn Hospice and this is her story:

'I have never needed the hospice personally but that doesn't mean I haven't witnessed through friends and family the amazing support and care they provide, one day I might even need them myself.

Running the marathon will push me physically and mentally to my limit, possibly beyond so I'm going to need a good reason to do it, what better reason than to do it for someone else?

Severn Hospice is with families from the moment they're referred to its care for as long as they need it, and it does this every day, all day for anyone in Shropshire, Telford & Wrekin and Mid Wales who needs that help. It does this for them for free, but it is not without cost and it can't happen without you. For every £1 you donate, they will spend 83p directly on care and use the remaining 17p to make another £1. Last year, all those individual donations helped provide more than £9m of caring services. Thank you - you're amazing!.'
