#### <u>Uniform</u>

#### Scopay - Dinner orders

As you will know, our scopay system is used for dinners, after school clubs, Breakfast club and hub bookings/payments.

Meal registers for our Cook are run from this system daily so **please ensure you book your child's meal by midnight the night before it is required**. If meals are not ordered and paid for then they will not be included on the meal register.

Sandwich order form are available form the school office or website and must be submitted the week before they are required.

Universal Infant Free School Meal (Reception to Year 2) and Free School Meal eligible pupils will still need their meals ordering on the system to ensure they come through on the registers. <u>Please do not assume because they are 'free' that they will automatically get a meal made for them.</u>
