

Staff will also be able to answer any particular queries you may have at that time.




# Monday 1st July:

These activities will be Character Education lessons, with a focus on well being and relationships. They will be based on getting to know each other and celebrating differences and diversity within the classroom.



## **The Summer Term at Apley Wood**

#### What happens at this time of the year at Apley Wood?

Year 6 look forward to moving to their Secondary Schools and all the other children in our school begin to think about moving up to their next year group and of the changes this will bring.

Classes do alter for many reasons, as the year goes on. As a staff, we review our classes annually to ensure they continue to be as balanced as we can make them.

This brings positive benefits for the children, as they grow in confidence, widening their social groupings and circles of friends. It can give some children a 'fresh start'.

We are also able to target our available support more efficiently. We will involve the children in the process, so that we have their input before we draw up class lists.

For the academic year 2024-2025 we have decided that current Year 2, Year 3 and Year 4 classes will not be mixed and will move up as their current classes. We feel that the balance of these classes is appropriate at the current time.

The other year groups (current reception, Year 1 and Year 5) will be mixed into different class groups.



#### **Worries**

We do appreciate that children will sometimes have worries about:

- Moving to a new class
- A new room
- A new teacher
- Level of work
- Changes of friends



We will ensure that things are all discussed in an open and supportive way.

## **Something Special!**

There are always lots of special things in each year group for the children to look forward to...

For example:

Upper Key Stage 2 (years 5 and 6)— Opportunities to be House Captains, to go to Arthog, become librarians, buddies, take part in a London Residential trip.

Lower Key Stage 2 (Years 3 and 4) — Telford Music Service lessons, opportunity to go swimming, Arthog Outreach.

Key Stage 1 (Years 1 and 2) — Lots of different visits to look forward to!

#### **Planned Timetable of activities**

## Early June 2024

Summer term assessment data collated.

Staff begin transition activities with their own classes. For the current Reception, Year 1 and Year 5 children where we are mixing classes, this will include completion of "Character Education Smooth Move" activity with children, to confirm preferred friendship groupings.

We cannot guarantee that children will be with all of their friends next year, but we will make every effort to ensure they are with at least one of them. Once we have finalised the class groupings the children will take part in smooth move morning in their new classes and meet their teachers.

9.00am - 11.30am: Reception & KS1

9.00am - 12.00pm: KS2

Parents are informed about staff and classes for September on smooth move day. The class groupings cannot be changed after this date.
